Grade Levels: 1-4

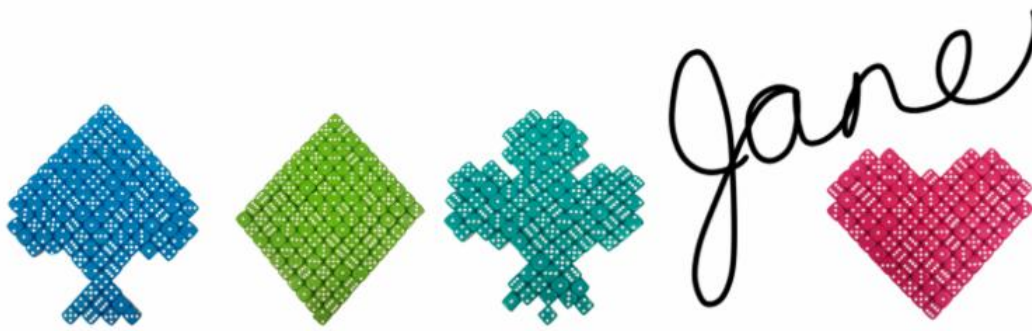
