To start off this week, we're featuring TENS in all their glory! Learning to work with tens is fundamental for both primary and elementary students. It is crucial that students become familiar with the relationship between tens, hundreds and thousands (etc...) in order to understand the exponential power of place value. Start with a ten frame for K-grade one (Jane will show you how in Make Ten). Have your students use counters or cups before moving on to making tens with dice.

As for the older students, note the way Jane "Chunks" her shaker to read place value to the million. Breaking the number up into manageable segments makes it easier for students to read.
